that has more deer then people, a subtropical climate with abundant food and



The trophy stags average 32 inches a side with three sweeping tines per antler. The odds are definitely with the hunter when you can expect to see from 100 to 200 deer per day. Just two



hours north of New Zealand, New Caledonia features a truly unique subtropical hunting locale. We have partnered with Dr. Daniel Marhic and his guiding company of "Trophy Rusa Deer".
